ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 3(f)(iv) OF BOND ORDINANCE #6-2019 OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MOUNT OLIVE, IN THE COUNTY OF MORRIS, NEW JERSEY, FINALLY ADOPTED MARCH 6, 2019, AS AMENDED BY ORDINANCE #12-2022 AND ORDINANCE #23-2022 FINALLY ADOPTED APRIL 19, 2022 AND AUGUST 9, 2022, RESPECTIVELY, IN ORDER TO INCLUDE AN ADDITIONAL PROJECT.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWNSHIP COUNCIL OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MOUNT OLIVE, IN THE COUNTY OF MORRIS, NEW JERSEY (not less than two-thirds of all members thereof affirmatively concurring) AS FOLLOWS:

Section One.
