ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 3(f)(iv) OF BOND
ORDINANCE #6-2019 OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MOUNT
OLIVE, IN THE COUNTY OF MORRIS, NEW JERSEY,
FINALLY ADOPTED MARCH 6, 2019, AS AMENDED BY
ORDINANCE #12-2022 AND ORDINANCE #23-2022
FINALLY ADOPTED APRIL 19, 2022 AND AUGUST 9,
2022, RESPECTIVELY, IN ORDER TO INCLUDE AN
ADDITIONAL PROJECT.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWNSHIP COUNCIL OF THE TOWNSHIP OF
MOUNT OLIVE, IN THE COUNTY OF MORRIS, NEW JERSEY (not less than two-thirds
of all members thereof affirmatively concurring) AS FOLLOWS:

Section One. Section 3(f)(iv) of Bond Ordinance #6-2019 of the Township of
Mount Olive, in the County of Morris, New Jersey (the "Township"), finally adopted March
6, 2019, as amended by Ordinance #2-2022 and Ordinance #23-2022 finally adopted
April 19, 2022 and August 9, 2022, respectively, is hereby amended to include office
renovations and equipment and to read as follows:

lighting-tables and chairs for
maintenance and qualifications-
charging barrels-10 by 20 pop up tent
and office renovations and
equipment, including all work and
materials necessary therefor and
incidental thereto and further
including all related costs and
expenditures thereto.



Section Two. The Township hereby certifies that it has adopted a capital budget or a temporary capital budget, as applicable. The capital or temporary capital budget of the Township is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this ordinance to the extent of any inconsistency herewith. To the extent that the purposes authorized herein are inconsistent with the adopted capital or temporary capital budget, a revised capital or temporary capital budget has been filed with the Division of Local Government Services.

Section Three. This ordinance shall take effect 20 days after the first publication thereof after final adoption, as provided by the Local Bond Law.
