ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MOUNT OLIVE, IN THE COUNTY OF MORRIS AND STATE OF NEW JERSEY, AMENDING SECTION 375-18, VEHICLES OVER CERTAIN WEIGHTS EXCLUDED, OF THE TOWNSHIP CODE TO ESTABLISH A UNIFORM VEHICLE WEIGHT LIMIT ON A SECTION OF WATERLOO VALLEY ROAD

WHEREAS, there currently exists a need to establish a uniform vehicle weight limit on a certain section of Waterloo Valley Road due to a railroad crossing and steep grade making it difficult for large commercial traffic to navigate; and

WHEREAS, the Township Chief of Police has reviewed and approved such a limit; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council of the Township of Mount Olive have determined that it is in the best interest of the Township to make this change.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Township of Mount Olive, in the County of Morris and State of New Jersey, as follows:

SECTION 1. Part II, General Legislation, Chapter 375, Vehicles and Traffic, Article II, Traffic Regulations, § 375-18, Vehicles over certain weights excluded, of the Code of the Township of Mount Olive is hereby amended to include the following road and added to the existing roads already listed in the code:

Name of Street	Weight Limit (tons)	Location
Waterloo Valley Road	4	From Kinney Road to a point 1.8 miles east therefrom

SECTION 2. If any section, subsection, clause, or phrase of this Ordinance is for any reason held to be unconstitutional or invalid by any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the remaining portions of this Ordinance.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance may be renumbered for purposes of codification.


SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall take effect twenty (20) days following final passage, approval, and publication as required by law.
