AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MOUNT OLIVE, COUNTY OF MORRIS AND STATE OF NEW JERSEY, AMENDING CHAPTER 375, "PARKING, STANDING, AND STOPPING."

WHEREAS, the purpose of this Ordinance is to regulate parking on public streets within the Township of Mount Olive; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Township Council find it be in the best interest of the Township and its citizenry to limit parking on public streets within the Township of Mount Olive; and

WHEREAS, the provisions of this article imposing a limit on parking shall not relieve any person of the duty to observe other and more restrictive provisions prohibiting or limiting the stopping, standing or parking of vehicles as set forth in N.J.S.A. 39:4-138, any other New Jersey statute or as hereinafter provided.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Council of the Township of Mount Olive in the County of Morris and State of New Jersey as follows:

SECTION 1. Chapter 375, "Parking, Standing, and Stopping," Section 375-23 "No parking of certain trucks, vehicles, and trailers," of the Code of the Township of Mount Olive is hereby amended, to include:

§ 375-23 No parking of certain trucks, vehicles, and trailers.

No person shall park any truck or vehicle over 10,000 pounds (GVW), a school bus, any other type of bus, recreational vehicle, camper, boat or trailer within the limits of the Township of Mount Olive on any street, road, avenue or highway except as provided in this section.

- A. Emergency or temporary stopping or parking is permitted for a period of up to three hours so long as it does not create a hazard or impede traffic, and allows for safe passage of emergency vehicles.
- B. For any other reason not listed above, a waiver may be granted if approved by the Township of Mount Olive Police Department.
- **SECTION 2.** All Ordinances of the Township of Mount Olive that are inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.
- **SECTION 3.** If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, or phrase of this Ordinance is for any reason held to be unconstitutional or invalid, such decision shall not affect the remaining portions of this Ordinance.
- **SECTION 4**. This ordinance shall take effect twenty (20) days following final passage, approval, and publication as required by law.
