Ordinance #8-2020

ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$545,000, \$180,000 OF WHICH IS FROM THE OPEN SPACE FUND AND \$365,000 OF WHICH IS FROM A WATER QUALITY RESTORATION GRANT, FOR THE PREVENTION, MITIGATION AND CONTROL OF ALGAE BLOOMS IN AND BY THE TOWNSHIP OF MOUNT OLIVE, IN THE COUNTY OF MORRIS, NEW JERSEY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWNSHIP COUNCIL OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MOUNT OLIVE, IN THE COUNTY OF MORRIS, NEW JERSEY AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. \$545,000 is hereby appropriated by the Township of Mount Olive, in the County of Morris, New Jersey (the "Township"), \$180,000 of which is from the Open Space Fund and \$365,000 of which is from a State of New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection Water Quality Restoration Grant, for the prevention, mitigation and control of algae blooms, including all work and materials necessary therefor and incidental thereto and further including all related costs and expenditures incidental thereto.

Section 2. The Township hereby certifies that it has adopted a capital budget or a temporary capital budget, as applicable. The capital or temporary capital budget of the Township is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this ordinance to the extent of any inconsistency herewith. To the extent that the purposes authorized herein are inconsistent with the adopted capital or temporary capital budget, a revised capital or temporary capital budget has been filed with the Division of Local Government Services.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect after final adoption and publication and otherwise as provided by law.
