Ordinance #9-2020

BOND ORDINANCE AMENDING IN ITS ENTIRETY SECTION 3(g)(iii) OF BOND ORDINANCE #4-2020 OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MOUNT OLIVE, IN THE COUNTY OF MORRIS, NEW JERSEY, FINALLY ADOPTED MARCH 3, 2020, IN ORDER TO AMEND THE DESCRIPTION OF THE PROJECT.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWNSHIP COUNCIL OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MOUNT OLIVE, IN THE COUNTY OF MORRIS, NEW JERSEY (not less than two-thirds of all members thereof affirmatively concurring) AS FOLLOWS:

Section One. Section 3(g)(iii) of Bond Ordinance #4-2020 of the Township of Mount Olive, in the County of Morris, New Jersey (the "Township"), finally adopted March 3, 2020, is hereby amended in its entirety to include the turf football field at Turkey Brook Park and to read as follows:


"(iii) Acquisition of heating, ventilation and air conditioning units for the municipal building, acquisition of snow and ice removal equipment, replacement and repair of the fencing at Dan Jordan Park, replacement of garage doors at Drakes Brook Park and improvements to the Flanders Park multipurpose field and improvements to Turkey Brook Park, including, but not limited to, the turf football field, including all related costs and expenditures incidental thereto and further including all work and materials necessary therefor and incidental thereto."

Section Two. The Township hereby certifies that it has adopted a capital budget or a temporary capital budget, as applicable. The capital or temporary capital budget of the Township is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this bond ordinance to the extent of any inconsistency herewith. To the extent that the purposes authorized herein are inconsistent with the adopted capital or temporary capital budget, a revised


capital or temporary capital budget has been filed with the Division of Local Government Services.

Section Three. This bond ordinance shall take effect 20 days after the first publication thereof after final adoption, as provided by the Local Bond Law.
