



BOND ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 3(j)(ii) OF
BOND ORDINANCE #5-2018 OF THE TOWNSHIP OF
MOUNT OLIVE, IN THE COUNTY OF MORRIS, NEW
JERSEY, FINALLY ADOPTED FEBRUARY 27, 2018, IN
ORDER TO AMEND THE DESCRIPTION OF THE
PROJECT.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWNSHIP COUNCIL OF THE TOWNSHIP OF
MOUNT OLIVE, IN THE COUNTY OF MORRIS, NEW JERSEY (not less than two-thirds
of all members thereof affirmatively concurring) AS FOLLOWS:

Section One. The description in Section 3(j)(ii) of Bond Ordinance #5-2018 of
the Township of Mount Olive, in the County of Morris, New Jersey (the "Township"), finally
adopted February 27, 2018, is hereby amended to include heating, ventilation and air-
conditioning system improvements and replacement and to read as follows:


"3(j)(ii) The acquisition of various equipment, including enclosed trailers
and mowers, the acquisition and installation of building fire suppression
systems and heating, ventilation and air-conditioning system
improvements and replacement, including all related costs and
expenditures incidental thereto and further including all work and
materials necessary therefor and incidental thereto."

Section Two. The Township hereby certifies that it has adopted a capital budget
or a temporary capital budget, as applicable. The capital or temporary capital budget of
the Township is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this bond ordinance
to the extent of any inconsistency herewith. To the extent that the purposes authorized
herein are inconsistent with the adopted capital or temporary capital budget, a revised

capital or temporary capital budget has been filed with the Division of Local Government Services.

Section Three. This bond ordinance shall take effect 20 days after the first publication thereof after final adoption, as provided by the Local Bond Law.
