

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MOUNT OLIVE, IN THE
COUNTY OF MORRIS AND STATE OF NEW JERSEY, AMENDING
CHAPTER 270, NUISANCES, OF THE TOWNSHIP CODE TO
AUTHORIZE THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC WORKS AND ZONING
OFFICER TO ISSUE NOTICES OF VIOLATION

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Council of the Township of Mount Olive, in the County of Morris and State of New Jersey, as follows:

SECTION 1. Chapter 270, Nuisances, Section 270-2, Notice of Violation; reinspection, of the Township Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

§ 270-2 Notice of violation; reinspection.

The owner, tenant, lessee or occupant of any premises in violation of this article shall be given written notice of said violation by the Director of Public Works and/or Zoning Officer. Thereafter, said owner, tenant, lessee or occupant shall be allowed 10 days to abate the violation complained of. After said ten-day period, the Director of Public Works and/or Zoning Officer shall make a reinspection of the premises to determine whether the violation has been abated.

SECTION 2. If any section, subsection, clause, or phrase of this Ordinance is for any reason held to be unconstitutional or invalid by any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the remaining portions of the Ordinance.

SECTION 3. All ordinances or parts of ordinances of the Township of Mount Olive that are inconsistent herewith are repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.


SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall take effect twenty (20) days following final passage, approval, and publication as required by law.


