AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP COUNCIL OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MOUNT OLIVE REPEALING SECTION §4-41.5 OF ARTICLE IX AND ADDING SECTION §4-31.3 ARTICLE VII OF THE CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MOUNT OLIVE TO TRANSFER THE DIVISION OF BUILDINGS, GROUNDS AND PARKS TO THE DEPARTMENT OF ADMINISTRATION

WHEREAS, Section §4-41.5 of Article IX was added to the Code of the Township of Mount Olive on April 9, 2002 by Ordinance No. 13-2002 to establish within the Department of Public Works the Division of Buildings, Grounds, and Parks; and

WHEREAS, the Division of Buildings, Grounds, and Parks works more closely with the Department of Administration, specifically the Business Administrator and the Division of Recreation, than it does with the Divisions within the Department of Public Works; and

WHEREAS, the Township of Mount Olive finds that it is in the best interest of the Township of Mount Olive to repeal Section §4-41.5 of Article IX and to add Section §4-31.3 to Article VII of the Code of the Township of Mount Olive to transfer the Division of Buildings, Grounds, and Parks to the Department of Administration.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED the Township of Mount Olive as follows:

Section §4-41.5 of Article IX is hereby repealed; and

Section §4-31.3 shall be added to Article VII as follows:

The Division of Buildings, Grounds and Parks, which was created on April 9, 2002 by Ordinance No. 13-2002, is hereby transferred to the Department of Administration, under the supervision of the Supervisor of Buildings, Grounds and Parks with the following duties and responsibilities;

- A. Operate and maintain public buildings and grounds owned or leased by the Township.
- B. Provide custodial and janitorial service for all Township buildings.
- C. Administer publicly owned properties.
- D. Plant, care for and trim public parks and greens.
- E. Maintain and repair playfields and playgrounds and recreational areas and facilities, as requested by and pursuant to the instructions of the Division of Recreation.

This Ordinance shall take effect after final passage as provided by law.
