**AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MOUNT OLIVE,
IN THE COUNTY OF MORRIS, STATE OF NEW JERSEY,
PROVIDING FOR A STREET NAME CHANGE FROM WINDING HILL DRIVE EAST
AND WINDING HILL DRIVE WEST TO WINDING HILL DRIVE**

WHEREAS, a final plat for Woodfield at Mount Olive Section III-A, Lot 11, Block 8400, prepared by Michael D. Nolan, PLS, Chester, Ploussas, Lisowsky Partnership, dated May 30 , 2002 and revised through July 15, 2004 was filed which listed Winding Hill Drive East and Winding Hill Drive West on the final plat;

WHEREAS, this is a continuous road that was for some reason split into an East and West;

WHEREAS, it was decided by the Township that for a quicker emergency response and other safety reasons, this road should simply be listed as Winding Hill Drive;

WHEREAS, the Kaplan Group was never asked to change the final plat to make this change;

WHEREAS, the Township of Mount Olive wishes to adopt an ordinance changing the name of Winding Hill Drive East and Winding Hill Drive West to Winding Hill Drive;

WHEREAS, the renaming of this road is desired in the interest of public safety in the event of emergency response and for other safety reasons, and for consistency;

BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Council of the Township of Mount Olive, in the County of Morris, and State of New Jersey, as follows:

1. That the Township Engineer and the Township Tax Assessor for the Township of Mount Olive be and are hereby authorized and directed to amend the official map and the official Tax Map of the Township of Mount Olive, Morris County, New

Jersey, to rename what the original final plat listed as Winding Hill Drive East and Winding Hill Drive West to Winding Hill Drive; and

2. That the Township Clerk be and hereby is authorized and directed to amend the Township Code in all places to reflect the change of name from Winding Hill Drive East and Winding Hill Drive West to Winding Hill Drive; and
3. That the Township Clerk be and hereby is authorized and directed to file a certified copy of this Ordinance with the Morris County Registrar, the Morris County Superintendent of Elections, the New Jersey Secretary of State, the Township of Mount Olive Postmaster and any other County, State or Federal Agency which requires a notification of a road name change.

SECTION 1. All ordinances of the Township of Mount Olive, which are inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance, are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

SECTION 2. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance is for any reason held to be unconstitutional or invalid by any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the remaining portions of this Ordinance.

SECTION 3. This ordinance may be renumbered for purposes of codification.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall take effect twenty (20) days upon final passage, approval, and publication as required by law.
