ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$212,016 TO BE RECEIVED

FROM THE 2013 MORRIS COUNTY HISTORIC

PRESERVATION TRUST FUND FOR IMPROVEMENTS TO

THE FORMER BAPTIST CHURCH IN AND BY THE

TOWNSHIP OF MOUNT OLIVE, IN THE COUNTY OF

MORRIS, NEW JERSEY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWNSHIP COUNCIL OF THE TOWNSHIP OF

MOUNT OLIVE, IN THE COUNTY OF MORRIS, NEW JERSEY AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. \$212,016 which is expected to be received from the 2013 Morris County

Historic Preservation Trust Fund is hereby appropriated for: a) the completion of construction

documents for improvements to the Former Baptist Church, consisting of interior restoration of

finishes, mechanical, electrical and plumbing upgrades, and structural repairs and b) all exterior

restoration, including all work and materials necessary therefor and incidental thereto in and by

the Township of Mount Olive, in the County of Morris, New Jersey (the "Township").

Section 2. The Township hereby certifies that it has adopted a capital budget or a

temporary capital budget, as applicable. The capital or temporary capital budget of the Township

is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this ordinance to the extent of any

inconsistency herewith. To the extent that the purposes authorized herein are inconsistent with

the adopted capital or temporary capital budget, a revised capital or temporary capital budget has

been filed with the Division of Local Government Services.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect after final adoption and publication and

otherwise as provided by law.
