ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$32,850, \$6,570 OF WHICH IS FROM THE OPEN SPACE TRUST FUND AND \$26,280 OF WHICH IS FROM THE MORRIS COUNTY HISTORIC TRUST FUND FOR THE SEWARD HOUSE - PRESERVATION PLAN AND CONSTRUCTION DOCUMENTS IN AND BY THE TOWNSHIP OF MOUNT OLIVE, IN THE COUNTY OF MORRIS, NEW JERSEY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWNSHIP COUNCIL OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MOUNT OLIVE, IN THE COUNTY OF MORRIS, NEW JERSEY AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. \$32,850 is hereby appropriated, \$6,570 of which is from the Open Space Trust Fund and \$26,280 of which is from the Morris County History Trust Fund for the Seward House - Preservation Plan and Construction Documents, including all work and materials necessary therefor and incidental thereto and further including all related costs and expenditures incidental thereto, in and by the Township of Mount Olive, in the County of Morris, New Jersey (the "Township").

Section 2. The Township hereby certifies that it has adopted a capital budget or a temporary capital budget, as applicable. The capital or temporary capital budget of the Township is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this ordinance to the extent of any inconsistency herewith. To the extent that the purposes authorized herein are inconsistent with the adopted capital or temporary capital budget, a revised capital or temporary capital budget has been filed with the Division of Local Government Services.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect after final adoption and publication and otherwise as provided by law.
