BOND ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 1 OF BOND ORDINANCE NUMBERED 11-2011 OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MOUNT OLIVE, IN THE COUNTY OF MORRIS, NEW JERSEY FINALLY ADOPTED APRIL 26, 2011 IN ORDER TO AMEND THE DESCRIPTION OF THE PROJECT

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWNSHIP COUNCIL OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MOUNT OLIVE, IN THE COUNTY OF MORRIS, NEW JERSEY (not less than two-thirds of all members thereof affirmatively concurring) AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1 of Bond Ordinance numbered 11-2011 of the Township of Mount Olive, in the County of Morris, New Jersey (the "Township"), finally adopted April 26, 2011, is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 1. \$37,500 is hereby appropriated, all of which will be funded by a Green Acres Grant from the State of New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection, for the acquisition of property, more specifically known as Block 8000, Lot 8 on the tax maps of the Township of Mount Olive, in the County of Morris, New Jersey (the "Township"), including all related costs and expenditures incidental thereto."

Section 2. The Township hereby certifies that it has adopted a capital budget or a temporary capital budget, as applicable. The capital or temporary capital budget of the Township is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this ordinance to the extent of any inconsistency herewith. To the extent that the purposes authorized herein are inconsistent with the adopted capital or temporary capital budget, a revised capital or temporary capital budget has been filed with the Division of Local Government Services.

Section 3. This bond ordinance shall take effect 20 days after the first publication thereof after final adoption, as provided by the Local Bond Law.
