AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MOUNT OLIVE, COUNTY OF MORRIS, STATE OF NEW JERSEY AMENDING CHAPTER 245, VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC, OF THE REVISED GENERAL ORDINANCES WEIGHT LIMITS

BE IT ORDAINED by the Municipal Council of the Township of Mount Olive, County of Morris, State of New Jersey, as follows:

SECTION 1. Chapter 245, Vehicles and Traffic, Section 245-51, Schedule XII: Vehicles Over Certain Weights Excluded, of the aforesaid Revised General Ordinances is hereby amended to read as follows:

§ 245-51. Schedule XII: Vehicles Over Certain Weight Excluded.

In accordance with the provisions of § 245-41, trucks in excess of the gross weights indicated are hereby excluded from the following streets or parts thereof, except for pickup and delivery of materials on such streets:

Name of Street	Weight (tons)	Location
Tinc Road	5	Entire Length
Drakestown Road	5	From Cathy Lane to River Road

SECTION 2. All ordinances of the Township of Mount Olive which are inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

SECTION 3. If any section, subsection, clause or phrase of this ordinance is for any reason held to be unconstitutional or invalid by any court or competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the remaining portion of this ordinance.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance may be renumbered for purposes of codification.

SECTION 5. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon final passage, approval and publication as required by law.
