ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MOUNT OLIVE, COUNTY OF

MORRIS, NEW JERSEY APPROPRIATING \$250,000 FOR THE

ACQUISITION OF CERTAIN PROPERTY, SUCH APPROPRIATION

CONSISTS OF A \$250,000 GREEN ACRES GRANT FROM THE STATE

OF NEW JERSEY DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL

PROTECTION

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWNSHIP COUNCIL OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MOUNT

OLIVE, IN THE COUNTY OF MORRIS, NEW JERSEY AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. \$250,000 is hereby appropriated, all of which will be funded by a Green Acres Grant from

the State of New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection, for the acquisition of property and more

specifically described as Block 7000, Lots 64.01 to 64.17 and Lot 65 on the tax maps of the Township of

Mount Olive, in the County of Morris, New Jersey (the "Township"), including all related costs and

expenditures incidental thereto.

Section 2. The Township hereby certifies that it has adopted a capital budget or a temporary capital

budget, as applicable. The capital or temporary capital budget of the Township is hereby amended to conform

with the provisions of this ordinance to the extent of any inconsistency herewith. To the extent that the

purposes authorized herein are inconsistent with the adopted capital or temporary capital budget, a revised

capital or temporary capital budget has been filed with the Division of Local Government Services.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect as provided by the law.
