AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MOUNT OLIVE, COUNTY OF MORRIS, AND STATE OF NEW YERSEY AMENDING CHAPTER 400, LAND USE, ARTICLE III, GENERAL ADMINISTRATION; BUILDING CONSTRUCTION; PERMITS, SECTION 400-18, FEES, OF THE REVISED GENERAL ORDINANCES

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Municipal Council of the Township of Mount Olive, in the County of Morris, and State of New Jersey, as follows:

SECTION 1. Chapter 400, Land Use, Article III, General Administration; Building Construction; Permits, Section 400-18, Fees, of the aforesaid Revised General Ordinances is hereby amended and supplemented with the addition of subsection (K) to read as follows:

§400-18. Fees.

K. Driveways. In accordance with §400-43, all applications for permits for new driveways or modifications made to existing driveways, that change slope, contour, material to construct driveway or footprint, shall be directed to the Township Engineer with an application fee of \$25.00.

SECTION 2. All ordinances of the Township of Mount Olive, which are inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance, are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

SECTION 3. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance is for any reason held to be unconstitutional or invalid, such decision shall not affect the remaining portions of this Ordinance.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance may be renumbered for purposes of codification.

SECTION 5. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon final passage, approval and publication as required by law.
